Col Michael S. Maloney is the Commander, 932d Operations Group, Scott Air Force Base, Illinois. The 932 OG consists of the 73rd Airlift Squadron, 932nd Aeromedical Evacuation Squadron, and 932nd Operations Support Flight within the 932d Airlift Wing. The 932d Airlift Wing is responsible for providing first-class, worldwide, safe and reliable airlift for our nation's senior political and military leaders and their staffs; a first-rate global aeromedical evacuation capability from combat areas of responsibility.

He also served as the Assistant Director of Operations for a special operations squadron and VIP airlift squadron. In 2014, Col Maloney deployed to Entebbe, Uganda as commander of the Joint Special Operations Detachment-Uganda and the 6th Expeditionary Special Operations Squadron leading combat air operations in central Africa during Operation Observant Compass. He has worked staff positions as Chief, Foreign Language Training, Air Force Special Operations Command and as Senior Director, Air Force Special Operations Command Air Operations Center. In addition, in 2015 Col Maloney was the USAFE/AFAF liaison officer to US Africa Command. Col Maloney is also designated as a Regional Affairs Strategist.



Col Maloney has flown more than 5,000 military and civilian flight hours in the T-43, T-37, T-39, T-1, C-130E, MC-130E, L-382G, C-145, and C-40. He has supported Operations Desert Fox, Allied Force, Iraqi Freedom, Enduring Freedom and Observant Compass.
