Colonel Christopher R. Simpson is Mission Support Group Commander, 932d Mission Support Group, one of four groups assigned to the 932d Airlift Wing, Scott Air Force Base, Illinois. He is responsible for administration and oversight of programs to develop and train roughly 280 personnel assigned to Civil Engineer, Security Forces, Force Support Squadrons and a Logistics Readiness Flight. As the MSG, he supports the 932d Airlift Wing's mission to provide citizen Airmen supporting national interests worldwide through Distinguished Visitor (DV) airlift, expeditionary combat support, and ground/aeromedical care.

Colonel Simpson is originally from Virginia Beach, Virginia and received his commission from The Citadel. His assignments include three squadron commands, one as the deployed Defense Force Commander at Kirkuk Regional Air Base, Iraq. He served eleven years on active duty, twelve years in Air Force Reserve Command, and has held senior positions on active duty, as a member of the Air Force Reserve, and as an Air Force civilian.



His assignments include four Major Command tours at Air Combat Command, Air Force Reserve Command, Air Force Special Operations Command, and Air Force Global Strike Command. Colonel Simpson is a GS-14 at Eglin AFB, Florida where he serves on the 96th Test Wing staff as the Director of Information Protection.
