COLONEL MICHAEL P. CRUFF

Colonel Michael Cruff is the Vice Commander, 932d Airlift Wing, Scott Air Force Base, IL. The wing, comprised of over 1,100 mission-ready Citizen Airmen, supports our national interests word-wide by providing distinguished visitor airlift, ground and aeromedical patient care and expeditionary combat support.

Colonel Cruff was commissioned in 1995 through the AFROTC program at University of Massachusetts-Lowell and attended Specialized Undergraduate Pilot Training at Columbus Air Force Base, Mississippi. Upon graduation, he was assigned to McGuire AFB, NJ where he served as a KC-10 Instructor Pilot and Chief Executive Officer. Colonel Cruff transitioned to Andrews AFB, Maryland, where he operated the C-21A and served as a Flight Commander, Chief of STAN/EVAL, Chief of Mobility and Assistant Director of Operations.

Colonel Cruff joined the Air Force Reserve unit program at McGuire AFB, New Jersey in 2005 where he employed the KC-10A. He served the 514th Air Mobility Wing as a Flight Commander, Assistant Chief Pilot and Northeast Tanker Task Force Director of Operations. He was selected for command of the 78th Air Refueling Squadron where his organization was partially-mobilized for his entire tenure in command. Colonel Cruff then served as the Deputy Operations Group Commander, 514th Operations Group, 514th Air Mobility Wing, Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst, New Jersey.



He has commanded combat and combat support missions in support of operations Allied Force, Desert Fox, Southern Watch, Desert Strike, Phoenix Scorpion, Noble Eagle, Enduring Freedom, Iraqi Freedom and New Dawn. Colonel Cruff has deployed/mobilized twelve times and has served as a deployed Director of Operations in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom/Enduring Freedom.

Prior to his current assignment Colonel Cruff served as the commander of the 954th Reserve Support Squadron and as Chief, United States Transportation Command Deployment Distribution Operations Center, Scott AFB, IL.

Colonel Cruff is a command pilot with more than 4,400 military flight hours.
