Colonel Edward T. Hunn currently serves as Commander of the 932d Mission Support Group, 932d Airlift Wing, Scott Air Force Base, Illinois. In this role, he leads Civil Engineers, Force Support, Logistics Readiness, and Security Forces Airmen. His team provides support services to wing personnel and is available to support additional personnel in mission partner organizations around Scott Air Force Base. The 932d Mission Support Group enables airpower and satisfies world-wide Combatant Commander needs with mission-ready Airmen.
